CALL FOR PAPERS

Following the 2009–2018 events with participants from a large number of countries, [Tallinn University of Technology](#) will host the 11th Conference “Economic Challenges in Enlarged Europe” from 16–18 June 2019 in Tallinn. The event is organised in collaboration with [Bank of Estonia](#) and Association for the Study of East European Economies and Cultures (USA).

You are invited to **submit papers for presentation and discussion**. We would especially encourage submissions on:

- macroeconomic effects and economic policy considerations under global change;
- consequences of economic fluctuations on the financial sector and related opportunities;
- real sector implications and labour market responses to the changing economic environment;
- economic development and convergence/disintegration issues in enlarged Europe;
- work arrangements in the changing socio-economic context;
- financial decisions and considerations in the complex economic environment;
- comparative regional studies (e.g. Nordic countries, CEE countries, Western/Southern European countries, non-EU countries etc).

Submissions on other topics falling under one of the thematic tracks below are also very welcome.

SUBMISSIONS

Authors are invited to submit **extended abstracts** of their papers by **15 March 2019**. The Academic Committee will review all submissions and the submitting authors will be notified of the decision by 1 April 2019.

After notification of acceptance, a full paper must be submitted by **15 May 2019**. Formatting and submission instructions are available on our [website](#).

If you wish your paper to be considered for publication in one of the above journals, please submit by **1 August 2019** (I round), or if not ready by that time, by **15 September 2019** (II round) your **final full paper**. Papers will be reviewed for the above journals following their normal review criteria, and a limited number of outstanding papers will be published by the journals.

PROGRAM OUTLINE

The venue will be [Hotel Europa](#), a 4-star conference hotel in Tallinn city centre. The event will begin with Welcome Reception in the evening of Sunday, 16 June at a special venue. The Welcome Reception is preceded by a combined bus and walking tour in Tallinn for those who are interested. Monday, 17 June will start with a plenary session in the morning, followed by parallel sessions until evening. The day will end with conference dinner at a restaurant in Tallinn city centre. Tuesday, 18 June will be devoted to parallel sessions.
